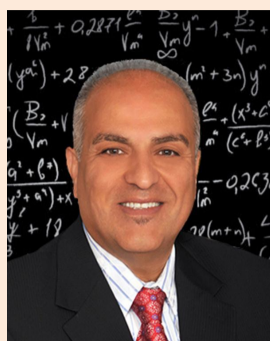

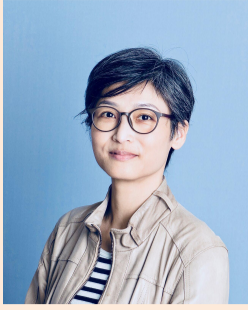
Keynote Speaker

Deakin University, Australia

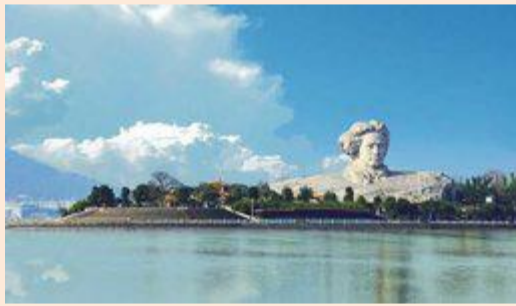
Dr. Kris Law is currently the Associate Professor in Engineering Management and Education, in the School of Engineering, Deakin University, Australia. She also holds a Docentship (adjunct professorship) in the Department of Industrial Engineering and Management, Oulu University in Finland.

Dr. Law obtained her PhD in Organization Learning and MPhil in Machining Processes as well a first degree in Industrial Engineering, at the City University of Hong Kong. She undertook a post-doctoral research scholarship in the National Taiwan University on a regional high-tech industry study and took up a visiting researcher position at the Graduate Institute of Industrial Engineering, National Taiwan University (2009-2011).

Her expertise lies in Organizational Learning and Development (OLD), Technological Innovation and Entrepreneurship (TIE), Engineering Education, and Smart Industrial Initiatives (SII). She has been invited as a visiting scholar in different countries, such as Taiwan, Thailand and Europe (Finland and Slovenia), and has been active as a professional OL consultant promoting project-based action learning (PAL) in high-tech organizations.

About Changsha, Hunan, China



Changsha, subordinate to Hunan Province is located in the north of eastern Hunan Province, the lower reaches of Xiangjiang and the western edge of the Changliu Basin. It is between 111°53'-114°15' of east longitude and 27°51'-28°41' of north latitude. It is adjacent to Yichun and Pingxiang in Jiangxi Province, Zhuzhou and Xiangtan in the south, Loudi and Yiyang in the west, and Yueyang and Yiyang in the north. It is about 230 kilometers long from east to west and about 88 kilometers wide from north to south. The area is 118,190 square kilometers, of which the urban area is 2185 square kilometers.

Changsha with a long history of 3000 years of which the city construction history is 2400 years, is the birthplace of Chu civilization and Xiangchu culture. Built in the Spring and Autumn Period, it belongs to Chu State. Because of the influence of Qu Yuan and Jia Yi, it is called "the hometown of Qu Jia". Changsha is also known as the "Chuhan Famous City". The excavation of important cultural relics such as Mawangdui Han Tomb and Jianmalou reflects its profound Chu culture and Hunan cultural heritage. The Yuelu Academy under Yuelu Mountain is a symbol of Hunan cultural education. Many celebrities have emerged in history, leaving many historical and cultural relics which make Hunan be the first national historical and cultural city.

On February 23, 2016, Changsha is ranked first among the top ten most happy provincial capital cities in the CCTV "China Economic Life Survey" in 2015. On May 6, 2016, China's first low-speed magnetic levitation line was opened in Changsha.
